THE NAME AND FAMILY OF COREY

The Corey family is stated to have been of Pict or Scandinavian origin, deriving its name from "Con", a Roman fort at Annandale in the shire of Dumfries, Scotland. We also find "Karre" in Holingshed's copy of "The roll of Battel Abbey in the Reign of William the Conqueror of England".

This indicates that the family is an ancient one, whatever its origin. The word corrie, or correi, is Gaelic, meaning a bowl-shaped hollow on a hillside, in which game usually lies.

Mrs. E. F. Corey, a descendant of William Corey of Portsmouth, Rhode Island, has concluded after years of research, "That all of the Coreys in America sprang from the same source, probably not from one man, but from several brothers, or relatives, who reached this country at or near Boston, from which place they, or their descendants, migrated through Massachusetts, Rhode Island, and Connecticut, crossing from the latter state to Long Island."

The surname Corrie, Corry, Cory, with mention of its heraldic insignia, is found in "Burke's Peerage", his "Landed Gentry" and "Commoners" as well as in his "Encyclopedia of Heraldry".

The illustration on the cover is the coat-armor granted to the Corey family of London in 1612. "Sable on a chevron between three griffins' heads erased, or as many estoiles gules. Crest-out of a ducal coronet a griffin's head between two wings, or each wing charged with three estoiles in pale gules." The same arms were born by the Coreys of Bremerton, Norfolk County, England.

The original of this illustration is an old print once owned by Mr. Corrie of Sag Harbor, Long Island, who brought a pitcher from London in 1799 engraved with the family arms.

Statements on this page were taken from the records of Charles T. Corey, Whitman, Massachusetts.

DIRECT LINEAGE OF JOSEPH S. COREY of Osceola, Wisconsin

The first part of this is incorrect, it is part of the Sir Francis Drake Scam.

Thomas Drake (youngest brother of Sir Francis Drake) married Elizabeth Aregore, and had one son who was named Francis. The son, Francis, became the first baronet.

Francis Drake, first baronet, (son of Thomas Drake and wife) married Jane Bampflyde and had no issue. She died. He then married for a second wife Joanne Stroud, and had 5 sons.

John Drake (3rd child of Francis, the first baronet, and his second wife Joanne) was born July 28, 1610. He married, had six children, and died in England.

John Drake, (first child of John Drake and wife) was born in England in 1657. He married Hannah Moore in America Nov. 30, 1692. They had 5 children.

John Drake (first child of John Drake and Hannah Moore) was born at Windsor, Conn. Sept. 15, 1694. He married Elizabeth Bissel April 14, 1722-3. They had 2 children, Elizabeth and Francis, the latter dying unmarried and without issue.

Elizabeth Drake (first and only married child of John Drake and wife) was born March 5, 1724. She married first William Corey (son of John Corey of North Kingston, R. I.) April 5, 1742. They had 2 sons. William Corey, her husband, died in 1746 or 7. She then married Thomas Corey (brother of her first husband) Feb. 15, 1748, and to them were born 4 children.

John Corey (first child of Elizabeth Drake and William Corey) was born April 7, 1745. He married Ann Allen in 1763 and had issue.

The remaining is of the Thomas Cory of Chelmsford Line. The actual lineage of Leonard Corey is Thomas¹, Thomas², Isaac³, Isaac⁴, Leonard⁵, Leonard⁶:

Leonard Corey (son of John Corey and wife) was born April 30, 1769. He married Mehitabel Davenport Nov. 3, 1791 and had issue.

Leonard Corey (first child of Leonard Corey and wife) was born May 28, 1792. He married Dec. 1, 1814 Adah Skinner, second child of Captain James Skinner, and had issue. He died Jan. 9, 1871. (Captain James Skinner, son of James Skinner, was born Dec. 6, 1753. He served in the Revolutionary War as a private and as corporal. After the war, he was captain of the Mansfield militia. He and his family are buried in the old cemetery near the town hall. Captain James Skinner died in August, 1832.)

Joseph Skinner Corey (fourth child of Leonard Corey and wife Adah) was born April 24, 1821 in Mansfield, Mass. He married Pamela Foster or Foxboro, Mass. June 17, 1841 and

had issue. Pamelia was born April 2, 1822 and died April 12, 1900 at the home his daughter, Mrs. Elizabeth Hale, in Osceola, Wis.

Joseph Skinner Corey came with his family from Mansfield, Mass. to Wisconsin in 1856 and lived in or near Osceola most of his life as a farmer. In 1865, he enlisted in the 4th Wisconsin Cavalry and served during the remainder of the Civil War, returning home in the spring of 1866. He died July 24, 1902 at Osceola, Wis. Joseph and Pamelia had 5 children: Elizabeth, William, Joseph Edgar, George and Frank.

The following paragraph may explain how they were taken in in the scam.

Mrs. Hannah Corey Grover of Cambridge, Mass., Joseph Skinner Corey's only sister, compiled the family lineage up to this point. She spent one summer in London. Assisted by an attorney, she searched old records and manuscripts for necessary information. We owe her a debt or gratitude. Our "Aunt Hannah" and Uncle Lucas Grover had two children, Eudora and Walter, who had no children.

Elizabeth Corey Hale, first child and only daughter of Joseph Skinner Corey and wife, Pamelia, was born in Mansfield, Mass. May 5, 1843. She moved with her parents to Osceola, Wis. in 1856. After teaching in the public schools of that area, she married Isaac Hale. For several years, she served as organist and choir leader in the Osceola Baptist church, where she was a faithful worker. Elizabeth, our beloved "Aunt Lizzie" to a host of Corey nephews and nieces, had no children, but she adopted her baby nephew, Fred Wallace, and brought him up as her own. She died Dec. 9, 1905 at Osceola, Wis.

William H. Corey, second child of Joseph and Pamelia, was born Feb. 23, 1847 in Mansfield, Mass. He died unmarried July 2, 1878 at Ceceola.

Joseph Edgar Corey, third child of Joseph Skinner Corey and wife Pamelia, was born in Mansfield, Mass. May 9, 1850. He was married to Medora Ayers of Farmington, Polk County, Wis. Jan. 16, 1876 by the Rev. E. W. Hurlburt, Baptist minister at Osceola Mills, Wis. Joseph Edgar was, for several years, a teacher in the public schools of Polk County, also a farmer in the Town of Garfield. He served as a rural mail carrier from 1900 to 1915. He and his wife, Medora, spent their retirement years on a small fruit farm at Ripon, Wis. He died at Wisconsin Rapids, Wisconsin Dec. 30, 1920 at the home of his son, Silas Grover Corey.

The following children were born to Joseph Edgar Corey and his wife, Medora: Jessie Edna, Bennie DeWitt, Silas Grover and Edith Elizabeth.
